Research three post secondary institutions

Acceptance in Post Secondary Institution

- What requirements are needed for an application to be accepted?
 - High school transcripts, GPA, ranking

 - Student history of extra curricular activities,
 volunteer activities

High School Preparation

- What high school courses are required by the institution for acceptance in a program?

Cost to Complete

- Compare the three institutions on the total cost to obtain a degree/certificate.

- Do they offer online courses that you can complete during summer break?

Completion Rates and Job Placement

- How well do the institutions do in assisting graduates obtain employment?
- What is the completion rate?
- What is the drop out rate?
- Does the institution offer internships?
